How will your Project or Activity achieve the Strategic Directions indicated in the Council Priorities on page 4?* Dance is a great way for young people to express themselves in a safe environment and get involved in a positive social activity in their communities. Dance is also great exercise! We can perform for our community and celebrate the great things young people do in Brimbank.

How do you know that there is a need for your Project or Activity?* Lots of young people in Brimbank are interested in hip hop culture, but attending class can be really expensive and hard to get to as there are not many dance schools. Free classes in local areas means dance will be available for those who cannot afford it or get to dance schools.

St Albans is the only free hip hop program in Brimbank, and they get 60 young people to classes.

Describe how other group's will be contributing or assisting you with this Project or Activity?*

The Youth Junction (Visy Cares Hub) will let us use one of their spaces weekly at no cost. Brimbank Youth Services will help us make our flyer and speak to the media.

Please describe the major benefits of your Project or Activity for the Brimbank community?*

Young people will be seen in a more positive way.

Hip Hop brings together people from lots of different countries.

Hip Hop is a positive way of us expressing ourselves.

The class will help people improve their dance skills and give young people a chance to perform.

Older members of the group will be positive role models for younger members.

More arts projects for young people to attend!

20 young people every week. Our performances at schools and in the community will be attended by 50-100 people.

We will take names, cultural background and age of participants at each session so we know how many people attend.
