### Our Actions Towards Recovery



Continuously review and evaluate the impact of actions and initiatives within this Plan via Progress Reporting

Support, guide and inform lead partners (the Department of Health (DH), Local Government Victoria, Department of Premier and Cabinet and Special Interest Group SIG) of Council's key response and recovery initiatives.

Analyse localised survey data about COVID-19 community recovery by conducting surveys via an outbound contact centre.



Work in partnership with State and Federal Governments ensuring a co-ordinated approach to COVID-19 key health and safety messaging.

Build upon emerging recovery trends and opportunities through the development of the Brimbank Council Plan (2021-2025)

In the event of further COVID-19 outbreaks activate, update and test the Business Continuity Framework with first review to be undertake in March 2021.
